



## **CANYON OF THE EAGLES NATURE PARK & RESORT PET POLICY**

Thank you for staying at Canyon of the Eagles (COTE) and bringing your pet(s). It is our intent to provide you and your furry friend with not only a wonderful and enjoyable stay, but also a safe one. For the comfort and safety of all guests and pets, we kindly request that all pet owners act responsibly and pets behave while visiting this unique nature based property.

### **Please read and adhere to the following pet policies:**

1. No more than two pet are allowed in my guest room.
2. I agree to pay a non-refundable fee of \$15 plus tax per pet per night.
3. I agree to properly remove and dispose of waste associated with my pet while visiting Canyon of the Eagles property. Failure to do so will result in a \$25 fee per occurrence.
4. I agree to pay Canyon of the Eagles for any necessary cleaning or repairs due to pet stains and/or damage as determined within the sole discretion of COTE. I authorize my credit card on file to be charged for the cost of these additional services.
5. I am responsible for the noise my pet creates and will ensure that my pet does not disrupt the quiet enjoyment of other guests. Failure to control excessive barking or disturbing other guests may result in removal from the park.
6. Pets must be attended to, leashed and in control at all times while visiting Canyon of the Eagles property, including the nature trails. Pets are not allowed to be tied to trees or other structures.
7. Pets are not allowed in food and beverage facilities, meeting spaces or the swimming pool area.
8. I understand my pet must be crated and/or I must be present in the guestroom if and while being serviced by resort staff unless other arrangement have been made in advance with Guest Services.

I respect nature, wild animals and the ecosystem at COTE. I will not let my pet chase, bother or hurt the wildlife. In addition, while on the trails, I will make sure to have plenty of water and take in consideration the health of my pet and humans.
